Hospitals will utilize CritiCall Ontario to access medical consultations and transfers for defined critically ill/emergent patients for MOHLTC mandatory cases that may require transfer to another hosp, within or outside of the LHIN. (Currently includes Neurosurgery/Spine & out of Country cases & any other cases that may be ministrymandated in the future).

CritiCall is considered when neurosurgery/spine & out of country transfers are required. However, in the best interest of the patient, the most expedient method of transfer is the highest priority. In many instances, this is west to Winnipeg tertiary centers. The physician caring for the patient makes these decisions with the best interests of the patient in mind.
