On behalf of the All Nations Hospital Project Planning Team, the Lake of the Woods District Hospital is seeking a Community Representative as a member of the All Nations Hospital Steering Committee. The length of the term will be for three years with the potential for renewal, depending on the subsequent phases of the capital project.

The All Nations Hospital is now in the planning stage. The new hospital will be one part of a redesigned all nations health care system which will better meet the needs of the people we serve. Planning is being done in full cooperation with all of our health care partners, including Indigenous groups.

The Steering Committee will have diverse representation from the broad geography being served and will oversee the recommendation for approval of all phases of the project planning, from the defining of the scope, identifying healthcare system and user requirements, design of the project components and, upon Ministry of Health and Long Term Care approval to move beyond the planning stage, subsequent phases of the capital project. The Committee will be responsible for key recommendations to the Board of Directors regarding the project.

The Committee Members will participate on a voluntary basis. There is no remuneration provided, however, mileage/travel expenses will be reimbursed to attend committee meetings and to visit other facilities during the course of the planning process.

The Steering Committee membership will be kept apprised of project progress through reporting from the Project Planning Team. Members will be expected to actively participate on the Committee and regularly attend all meetings.

The Community Representative should have an interest in the Hospital's role within a health system, an understanding of the population that is served by the hospital; experience with capital projects would be an asset. An application that outlines your experience and interest in serving will be required.
