LWDH has had a longstanding partnership with Changes and this integration is an opportunity to deliver a more seamless, coordinated experience for clients and their families in accessing addictions and mental health services. Linkages to traditional healing and cultural supports will also be available for Changes clients through the LWDH Indigenous Patient Relations Department.
